Food for Thought

The Old Testament concludes with a strong rebuke of the nation of Israel for a number of sins of both commission and omission. The word of the Lord through Malachi needs to be studied and applied by the citizens of the kingdom of God today. We must be careful to offer the unblemished sacrifices God desires (Malachi 1:6-14), As God's kingdom of priests we need to provide true instruction (Malachi 2:1-9). We must be faithful in all of our relationships and in our commitment to justice (Malachi 3:10-17). We must stand against sin and practice the kind of pure religion God desires (Malachi 3:1-7; James 1:27). We must honor God by confidently giving Him priority in our tithes and offerings in keeping with this word of exhortation:

"Return to me, and I will return to you,' says the LORD Almighty. But you ask, 'How are we to return? Will a man rob God? Yet you rob me.' But you ask, 'How do we rob you?' 'In tithes and offerings. You are under a curse — the whole nation of you — because you are robbing me. Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,' says the LORD Almighty, 'and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that you will not have room enough for it. I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not cast their fruit,' says the LORD Almighty. 'Then all the nations will call you blessed, for yours will be a delightful land,' says the LORD Almighty."

The tithe may be viewed as the baseline for Israel's giving. The freewill offerings they gave to God went over and above this baseline. God did not rebuke them for not giving enough. He rebuked them for what withholding their tithes and offerings said about their lack of confidence in Him as their provider.

As citizens of the Heavenly Kingdom we need to consider what our giving says about our faith in God. Do we believe: "God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work." (II Corinthians 9:8 NIV) Our faith in God should empower us to give generously of our time, talents and material goods to every good work. If we can't live with God on 90% of our income, we cannot live on 100% without Him.
