THE FAMILY CONNECTION

Romans 15:7 March 17, 2019



Have you ever made the decision to never go back to some place in particular?

Maybe it was a restaurant where the service was rude or slow or both, the food was colder than the person who brought it to you or the iced tea looked like gravy and the gravy like iced tea.

Maybe it was a certain hotel where the bed was hard, the pillow was hard, the water was hard, not to mention the person behind the counter was hard too (to get along with that is).

Or, unfortunately, it was a church that was not aware of your presence or the fact that God wasn't.

Or maybe it wasn't a place at all but a situation; an environment that is joyless or demeaning or abusive.

We have an example of one who made that decision and by their actions announced, "Over my dead body will I be caught there again!" It is found in the text we looked at last Sunday, Luke 7:36-50.

We know the reputation and the profession of the woman who kisses, washes and anoints Jesus when Simon would do none of those. She is a "street walker", a "lady of the evening", a prostitute. Simon knows it, the other guests know it, Jesus knows it, and the woman knows it. We know that instead of water she uses tears, instead of a towel she uses her hair, instead of kissing his hand she kisses his feet and instead of common oils she anoints him with expensive perfume. And it's this last gesture that declares, "I'm not going back."

In a time and place where hygiene was optional, sweat was in abundance and Old Spice was not yet invented, odor made intimacy difficult. The fragrance from a jar of perfume suspended on a chain around your neck wouldn't mask the stench of your shame but would help mask the stench in the air.

So, when she empties the contents of that jar and leaves it on his feet, she acknowledges that she is also leaving her former life at his feet as well.

And that is what happens when we are introduced to the grace of Jesus. Grace that can heal the broken heart of a sinful woman and soften the hard heart of a sinful man.

The scene leaves me in speechless wonder as there are places I no longer want to frequent, and I now know it is possible when I leave behind a jar empty of perfume and leave with a forgiven heart full of peace.
